Since our founding in 1990, we have helped families achieve the dream of homeownership, providing safe and stable homes for children and changed the course of families' lives for generations to come.

## What We Do...

We give Oneida County families hope for a better tomorrow through a combination of homeowner programs and construction services.



We engage hundreds of volunteers every year at our construction sites, events and projects to help us advance our mission. Volunteers are the heart of Habitat.

Our affiliate is recognized as a member of the Neighborhood Revitalization Initiative through Habitat International. We are strategically focusing our efforts in specific neighborhoods for a greater community-wide impact.

Currently we are building our third Energy Star rated home on the 300 block of Lansing Street in Utica and completing another home repair project through A Brush with Kindness program assisting senior homeowners.



We are launching Habitat for Heroes, a veteran's initiative to engage and serve our local veteran community. This project is designed to address the needs of those heroes with handicap accessible modifications and home repairs.
